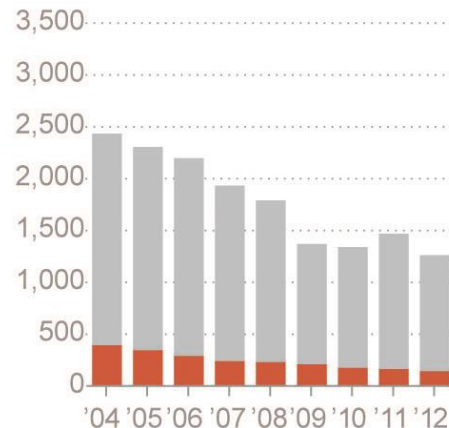
Rail safety improved in past decade

Train derailments dropped by half from 2004 to 2012 and incidents at railroad crossings fell by more than a third in the same period, according to federal data.

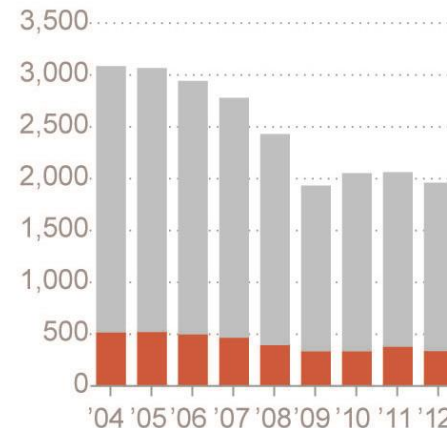
Railroad safety-related incidents, 2004-12

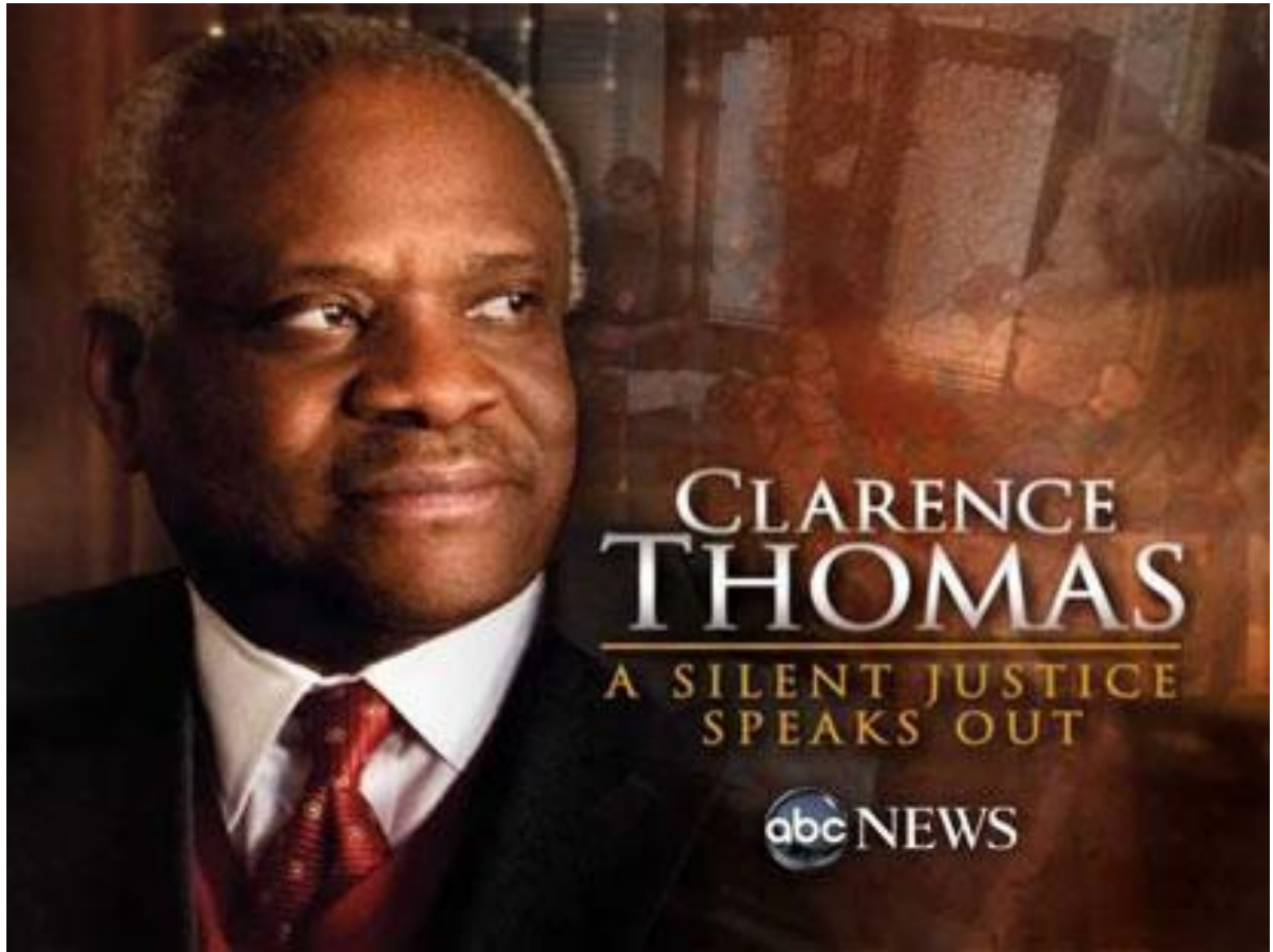

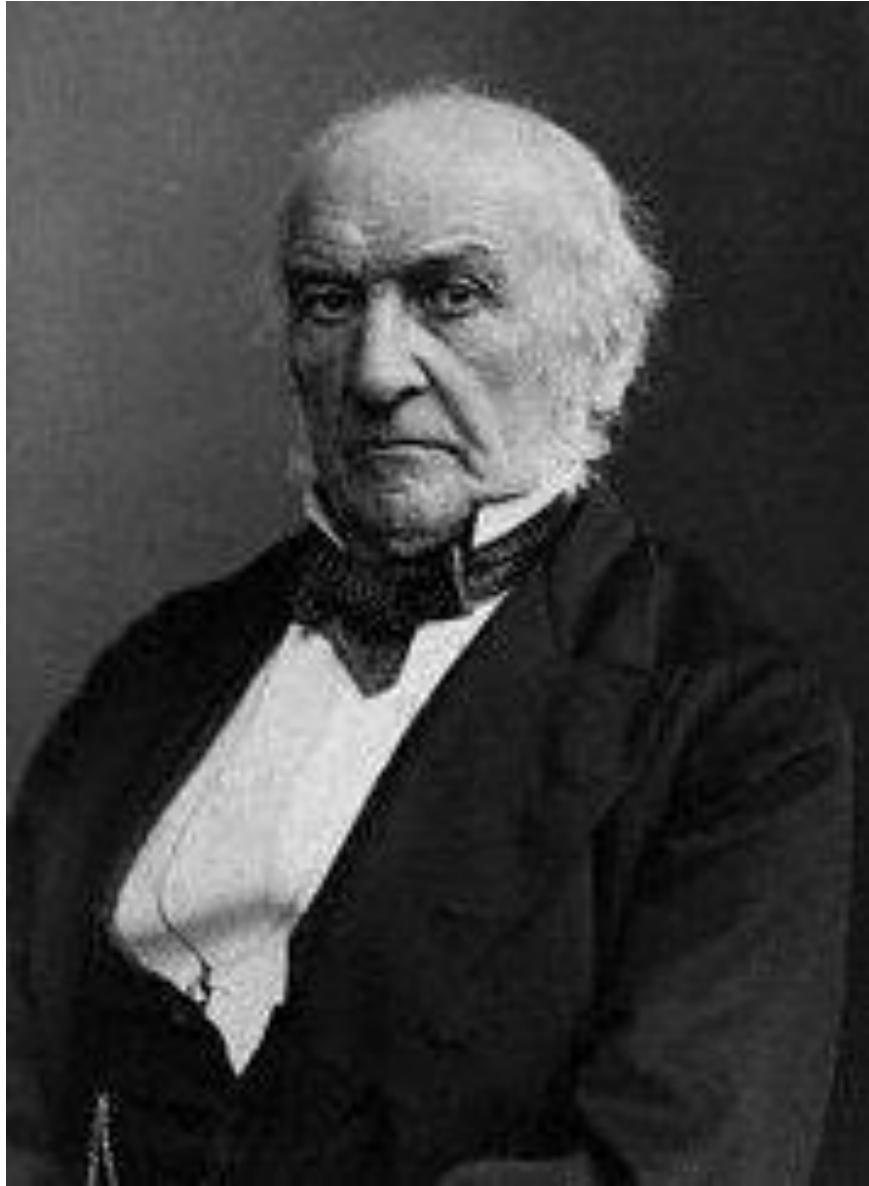

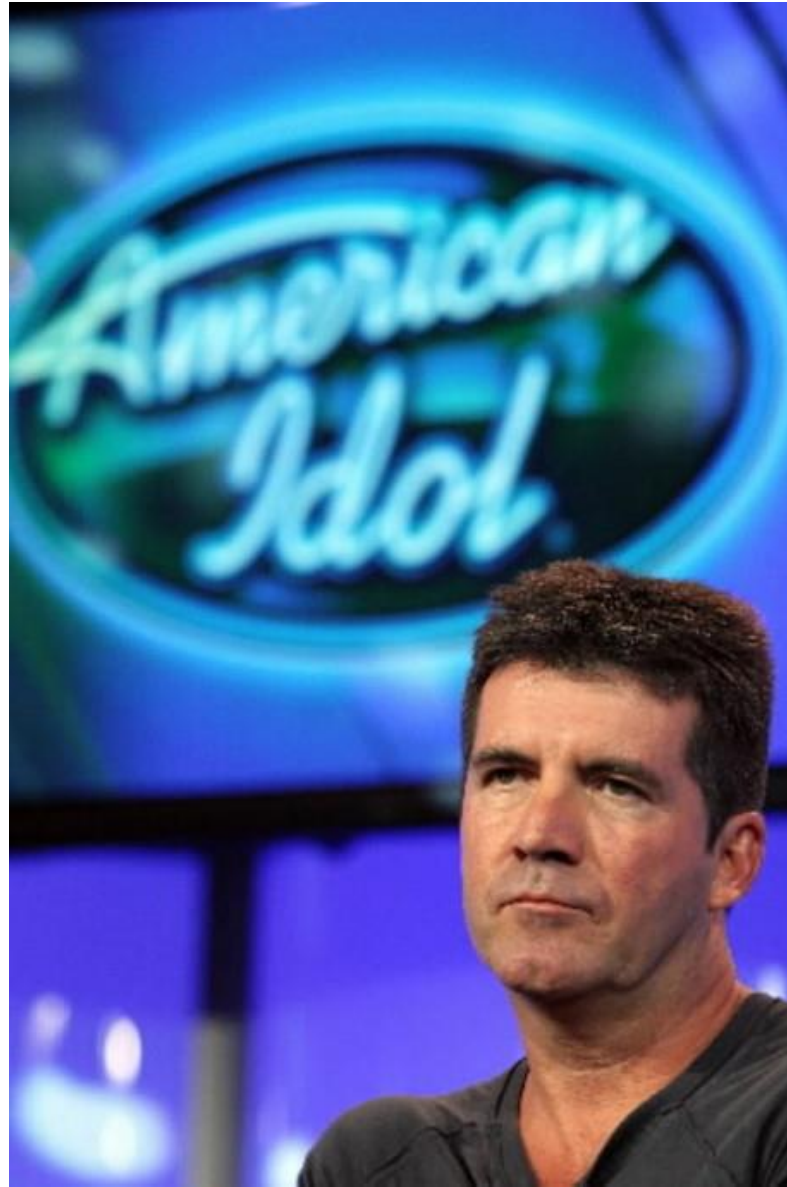
